

Passport to Adventure

Registration Process:

- ☞ **Register Online** at www.yosemitescouting.org. Go to Camping>Cub Day Camp. This includes link to medical form.
- ☞ Cub Scouts, Adult Volunteers, Youth Volunteers, and Tots can all be registered as separate participants *under the same registration* online.
- ☞ Check for availability/cost of Tot-Lot Program and age-requirements for specific camp.
- ☞ **Payment may be made online** with a small convenience fee **OR** bring in check/cash/credit card to Scout Service Center.
- ☞ Make checks payable to: Greater Yosemite Council.
- ☞ Follow the directions for the camp you are attending as to where/how to submit medical forms. **BSA MEDICAL forms (Parts A & B) are REQUIRED for ALL camp attendance.** http://www.scouting.org/filestore/HealthSafety/pdf/parts_ab.pdf
- ☞ Late registration 15 days before camp. Contact the **Camp Director** to make sure space and supplies are available.
- ☞ **CAMPERSHIPS** are available for Scouts with financial need. **Deadline: April 28, 2017.** Get information and forms at the Modesto or Stockton Service Center.

*Camp fees are **NON-REFUNDABLE** but **ARE** transferrable to a different camping program in the same calendar year.

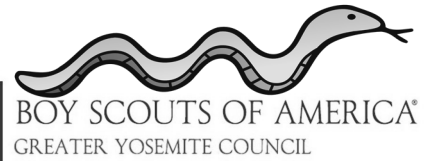
Additional Registration Information:

- ☞ **RANK at DAY CAMP:** Cub Scouts register at the rank level they will be working on when camp begins Summer of 2018. Cub Scouts who graduate to the next rank before camp should register to attend camp at the new rank.
- ☞ **VOLUNTEER STAFF:** The staff at our Cub Scout Day Camps is completely made up of volunteers. We need your help to meet BSA requirements for two-deep leadership!!
- ☞ Units sending 1-4 Scouts must also send 2 **FULL-TIME** adult volunteers. Units sending 5 - 9 Scouts must send 3 **FULL-TIME** adult volunteers. For all additional Scouts your unit must send 1 additional **FULL-TIME** volunteer at a ratio of 1 volunteer for every 1-5 Scouts (see chart at right for example).
