Rio del Oro District <u>Lifetime Achievement Award</u>

Criteria Standards for Award:

- ⇒ To recognize the District's Scouters who through a continued lifetime of strong service to the Boy Scouts and the Rio del Oro District have helped build and support a strong Scouting program for the betterment of youth.
- ⇒ The prestige of the award requires the criteria be general in nature to allow the members of the District Awards Committee to exercise wisdom, flexibility, and discretion in the evaluation and selection of a worthy recipient.
- ⇒ Although any past or present District Volunteer Scouter may be the recipient of the award they must meet the following criteria:
 - Presently Registered within the Scouting Movement
 - Recipient of District Award of Merit
 - <u>Continues to render</u> outstanding and dedicated service to the Scouting Movement with any registered position, that being on a Local Unit Level, District Level, Council Level, Area Level, Regional Level, National Level, or *ANY* volunteer Scouting position.
 - Member of the Boy Scouts of America for a minimum of 20 years.

Given the nature and prestige of the award, it is recommended that no more than ONE recipient be recognized in any one year, but there is no requirement of ANY award being granted in any one year.
