**To be TRAINED, you must:**

- Complete YOUTH PROTECTION TRAINING **every two years**

**AND**

- Complete your appropriate level of POSITION-SPECIFIC TRAINING for your position. A new position-specific training also is required when you change leadership roles.

- When:** Friday, September 14th from 7pm (class starts) through Saturday, September 15th at 5pm
- Where:** Overnight and training will be held at Camp Warren McConnell:  
11760 Livingston-Cressey Rd, Livingston
- Who:** Scoutmasters, and WEBELOS Den Leaders (Assistants to these positions as well as leaders who will eventually transition into these positions should take this training, as well). Venturing leaders and any adults may also take this training to learn outdoor skills.
- Cost:** **\$25.00** (\$35.00 after Monday, September 10th)
- Includes:** Printed materials, snacks, breakfast and lunch during the overnight session
- Bring:** Notebook, pen/pencil, current edition of handbook (Webelos, Boy Scout, etc.); uniform, tent/sleeping gear, appropriate clothing, camp chair, compass, pocket knife, flashlight, water bottle...no food prep gear required.
